

NC ROUTE CHANGES

ADOPTION OF TRAFFIC ENGINEERING ORDINANCES

NC ROUTE CHANGES

Division 3

Pender County

Add the following routing as NC 11, east and west of Atkinson:

NC 11-NC 53 from the Bladen County line, eastward to US 421, at Wards Corner.

Add the following routing as NC 11, east of Atkinson:

NC 11-US 421 from NC 53, at Wards Corner, northward to NC 11 west of Penderlea.

Division 6

Bladen County

Delete the following routing as NC 141 and add as NC 11 east of Elizabethtown:

NC 141 from the Columbus County line, northward to NC 53.

Add the following routing as NC 11 east of Elizabethtown:

NC 11-NC 53 from NC 141, eastward to the Pender County line, at Black River.

Columbus County

Delete the following routing as NC 141 and add as NC 11 east of Bolton:

NC 141 from US 74-76, northward to the Bladen County line.
