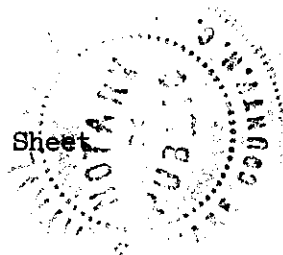

Division 5

Franklin County

Delete the following routing of NC 56 at Louisburg:

NC 56 (Bickett Boulevard) from the south intersection of US 401, north to NC 56-SR 1231 (E. Nash Street).

Delete the following routing of SR 1229 (S. Main Street) and add as NC 56 at Louisburg:

SR 1229 from US 401-NC 56, north to SR 1231 (E. Nash Street).

Delete the following routing of SR 1231 (E. Nash Street) and add as NC 56 at Louisburg:

SR 1231 from SR 1229 (N. Main Street), east to US 401-NC 39.
