US ROUTE CHANGES

Division 7

Guilford County

Delete the following routing of US 421 and add as a secondary road in and south of Julian:

US 421 from the Randolph County Line, northward to NC 62, in Julian.

Delete the following routing of US 421 in and north of Julian:

US 421 - NC 62 from NC 62, northward to its intersection with New Project 8.1583901 near SR 3379.

Add the following routing as US 421 west of Julian:

New Project 8.1583901 from the Randolph County Line, northward to NC 62, west of Julian.

Division 8

Randolph County

Delete the following routing of US 421 and add as a secondary road, in and near Liberty:

US 421 from its intersection with New Project 8.1583901, at SR 2464, south of Liberty, northward to the Guilford County Line.

Add the following routing as US 421 south and north of Liberty:

New Project 8.1583901 from its intersection with US 421 at SR 2464, south of Liberty, northward to the Guilford County Line.
