

NC ROUTE CHANGES

NC ROUTE CHANGES

Division 30

Bladen County

Delete the following routing of NC 211 and add as NC 211 Bypass west and east of Bladenboro:

NC 211 from the west intersection of SR 1211, eastward to the east intersection of SR 1211.

Delete the following routing of SR 1211 and add as NC 211 Business in and near Bladenboro:

SR 1211 from NC 211, a point 0.40 mile east of the Robeson County Line, eastward to NC 211, a point 0.20 mile west of SR 1134.
