

BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION

HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation by resolution dated July 24, 1973, delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways; pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350(a).

The Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation.

US ROUTE CHANGES

Division 4

Wilson County

Delete the following routing of US 264 Business and add as Secondary Roads in Wilson:

US 264 Business (Nash Street) from US 301, NC 58 (Ward Boulevard), northward to Hines Street.

US 264 Business (Hines Street) from SR 1553 (Nash Street), northward to Raleigh Road.

US 264 Business (Raleigh Road) from Hines Street, westward to US 264 Bypass (Ward Boulevard).

Delete the following routing of US 264 Bypass and add as US 264 in Wilson:

US 264 Bypass-US 301 (Ward Boulevard) from the west junction of US 264 Bypass-US 301, eastward to US 264-NC 58.

US 264 Bypass (Ward Boulevard) from US 301, northward to NC 42.

US 264 Bypass, NC 42 (Ward Boulevard) from NC 42, northward to US 264 (Raleigh Road).

US ROUTE CHANGES

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Division Engineer for each affected Division shall cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the action of the Secretary, and these ordinances shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of such signs.

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The Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation.

US AND NC ROUTE CHANGES

Division 13

Mitchell County

Delete the following routing of US 19-E and add as Secondary Roads in Spruce Pine:

US 19-E from a point 0.25 mile west of SR 1244, eastward to NC 226 (at the south end of the Toe River River Bridge).

US 19-E from NC 226 (at the north end of the Toe River Bridge), eastward to SR 1143.

Delete the following routing of US 19-E in Spruce Pine:

US 19-E - NC 226 from the south end of the Toe River Bridge, northward to the north end of the Toe River Bridge.

Delete the following routing of NC 226 and add as Secondary Road in Spruce Pine:

NC 226 from SR 1120, northward to the south end of the Toe River Bridge.

Add the following routing of NC 226 in Spruce Pine:

On Project 8.1855502 from SR 1120, northward to the south end of the Toe River Bridge.
