BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation by resolution dated July 24, 1973, delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways; pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350(a).

The Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation.

NC ROUTE CHANGE

Division 11

Wilkes County

Delete the following routing of NC 18-268 and add as NC 18 South-NC 268 West in North Wilkesboro:

US 421 Business-NC 18 South-NC 268 West (6th Street) from the intersection of US 421 Business-NC 18-268 ("B" Street) to "D" Street.

US 421 Business-NC 18 South-NC 268 West ("D" Street) from 6th Street, westward to new CBD loop (NC 18 South-NC 268 West).

The Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation.

US & NC ROUTE CHANGES

Division 4

Nash County

Delete the following routing of US 64 and add as NC 98 west and east of Spring Hope:

US 64 from SR 1331, eastward to US 64 Business, west of Nashville.

Delete the following routing of US 64 connector west of Spring Hope:

US 64 connector on New Project 6.804064, from NC 231, northward to the intersection with US 64-NC 98-SR 1331.

Add the following routing as US 64 west and east of Spring Hope:

US 64 along New Project 8.1158705 from NC 231, eastward to a point approximately 400 feet west of SR 1911, a distance of approximately 6.77 miles.

US 64 along New Project 8.1158706 from a point approximately 400 feet west of SR 1911, eastward to US 64 Business - US 64 Bypass, a distance of approximately 4.63 miles, west of Nashville.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Division Engineer for each affected Division shall cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the action of the Secretary, and these ordinances shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of such signs.
