HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation by resolution dated July 24, 1973, delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways; pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350(a).

The Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

Division 1

Bertie County

Delete the following routing of SR 1209 and add as NC 11 Business south of and in Aulander:

SR 1209 from the intersection with NC 11-SR 1221, northward to NC 305.

Delete the following routing of SR 1256 and add as NC 11 Business in and north of Aulander:

SR 1256 from NC 305, northward to the Hertford County line.

Delete the following routing of NC 11 and add as NC 11 Bypass southeast and north of Aulander:

NC 11-42 from SR 1209-SR 1221, northward to the Hertford County line.

Hertford County

Delete the following routing of SR 1204 and add as NC 11 Business north of Aulander:

SR 1204 from the Bertie County line, northward to the intersection of NC 11-NC 42.

Delete the following routing of NC 11 and add as NC 11 Bypass north of Aulander:

NC 11-42 from the Bertie County line, northward to SR 1204.
