HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation.

US ROUTE CHANGES

Division 14

Cherokee County

Delete the following routing of US 19-64-129 and add as US 19 Business in Murphy:

US 19-64-129 from SR 1556, northward to the intersection of US 64 (Peachtree Street).

Delete the following routing of US 19-129 and add as US 19 Business in and east of Murphy:

US 19-129 from US 64 (Peachtree Street), eastward to SR 1368.

Delete the following routing of US 19-129 and add as a Secondary Road west of Andrews:

US 19-129 from SR 1368, eastward to the east end of Project 8.3019120, west of Andrews.

Delete the following routing of US 64 and add as a Secondary Road in Murphy:

US 64 from Project 8.3019119, northward to US 19-64-129 (Hiwassee Street).

Add the following routing as US 19 Bypass-US 64-129 in Murphy:

US 19 Bypass-US 64-129, along Project 8.3019119, from SR 1556, eastward to US 64 (Peachtree Street).

Add the following routing as US 19 Bypass-US 129 in and east of Murphy:

US 19 Bypass-US 129 from US 64 (Peachtree Street), eastward along Project 8.3019119 to SR 1368.
