US ROUTE CHANGES

Division 2

Craven County

Delete the following routing of US 70 Business west and in New Bern:

US 17-US 70 Business, from US 70 Bypass, northeastward to NC 55.

Delete the following routing of US 70 and add as US 70 Bypass west of New Bern:

US 70 from SR 1309, eastward to US 17.

Delete the following routing of SR 1309 and add as US 70 Business west and in New Bern:

SR 1309 from US 70-US 70 Bypass, northward to NC 55.

Add the following routing as US 70 Business in New Bern:

US 70 Business-NC 55 from SR 1402, eastward to US 17.

US ROUTE CHANGES

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Division Engineer for each affected Division shall cause to be erected appropriate signs indicating the action of the Secretary, and these ordinances shall be in full force and effect from and after the erection of such signs.
