Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

US ROUTE CHANGES

Division 7

Guilford County

Add the following routing as US 220 south of Greensboro:

On New Projects 8.1535804-8.1535805 and 8.1535806 from the Randolph County Line, northward to a point 500 feet north of I-85.

Delete the following routing of US 220 and add as Secondary Road south of Greensboro:

US 220 from the Randolph County Line, northward to I-85.

Add the following routing of US 220 south of Greensboro:

I-85-US 29-70-220 from New Project 8.1535806, northeastward to I-40.

I-40-I-85-US 29-70-220 from I-40, northeastward to existing US 220-SR 1452.

Delete the following routing of US 220 and add as US 220 Business at Level Cross:

US 220 from New Project 8.1535804, eastward to US 220 Business-US 220.
