

BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (See 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 3

NEW HANOVER COUNTY

Delete the following routing of NC 132 and add as a Secondary Road south of Castle Hayne:

NC 132 from SR 2048-1327, northward to US 117 at Castle Hayne.

Add the following routing as NC 132 north of Wilmington:

NC 132 from approximate Station No. 1319+00 line "L" at Big Gum Branch, northward along Project No. 8.1223327 to the Pender County Line, at the Northeast Cape Fear River.

DIVISION 3

PENDER COUNTY

Add the following routing as NC 132 south of Wallace:

NC 132 from the New Hanover County Line, at the Northeast Cape Fear River, northward along Projects 8.1223327, 8.1223330, 8.1223332 and 8.1223333 to US 117, a point approximately 0.30 mile north of SR 1315.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 6

ROBESON COUNTY

Delete the following routing of SR 1619 and add as NC 72 in Lumberton:

SR 1619 from I-95-US 301, eastward to NC 41, in Lumberton.

Add the following routing of NC 72 in Lumberton:

NC 41-NC 72 from the west intersection of NC 41, eastward to the east intersection of NC 41, in Lumberton.

Delete the following routing of SR 1620 and add as NC 72 in and southeast of Lumberton:

SR 1620 from the east intersection of NC 41, southeastward to US 74.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 14

CHEROKEE COUNTY

Delete the following routing of SR 1519 and add as NC 141 south and north of Peachtree north to south of Marble:

SR 1519 from US 64, northward to US 19-129, south of Marble, a distance of 8.20 miles.
