

BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 7

ORANGE COUNTY

Delete the following routing of NC 54 Business and add as a Secondary Road in Chapel Hill:

NC 54 Business (South Road) from Columbia Street (NC 86), eastward to US 15-US 501.

Delete the following routing of NC 54 Business and add as a Secondary Road in Chapel Hill:

NC 54 Business (Franklin Street) from the Carrboro corporate limit, eastward to Columbia Street (NC 86).

Delete the following routing of NC 54 Business and add as a Secondary Road in Carrboro:

NC 54 Business (Main Street) from NC 54 Bypass, eastward to the Chapel Hill corporate limit.

Delete the following routing of NC 54 Bypass and add as NC 54 in Carrboro and Chapel Hill:

NC 54 Bypass from Main Street in Carrboro, eastward to Columbia Street in Chapel Hill.

US 15 Business-US 501 Business-NC 86 (Columbia Street) from NC 54 Bypass, northward to South Road.

Delete the following routing of US 15 Business-US 501 Business-NC 54 Business-NC 86 and add as NC 86 in Chapel Hill:

US 15 Business-US 501 Business-NC 54 Business-NC 86 (Columbia Street) from South Road, northward to Franklin Street.

Delete the following routing of US 15 Bypass-US 501 Bypass-NC 54 Bypass and add as US 15-US 501-NC 54 in Chapel Hill:

US 15 Bypass-US 501 Bypass-NC 54 Bypass from Columbia Street (NC 86), eastward to South Road (NC 54).

Delete the following routing of US 15 Business-US 501 Business and add as a Secondary Road in Chapel Hill:

US 15 Business-US 501 Business (East Franklin Street) from Columbia Street (NC 86), eastward to US 15-501 Bypass.

Delete the following routing of US 15 Bypass-US 501 Bypass and add as US 15-US 501 in Chapel Hill:


US 15 Bypass-US 501 Bypass from South Road (NC 54), eastward to US 15 Business-US 501 Business (East Franklin Street).




