BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 3

DUPLIN COUNTY

Add the following routing of NC 903 in and south of Albertson:

NC 903-NC 111 from the intersection of NC 111-SR 1539, southward to the intersection of NC 11.

Add the following routing of NC 903 in and north of Kenansville:

NC 903-NC 11 from the intersection of NC 903-NC 11-NC 111, southward to the intersection of NC 24.

Add the following routing of NC 903, in Kenansville:

NC 903-NC 24-50-11 from the intersection of NC 24, southward to the intersection of NC 50-24.

Add the following routing of NC 903 in and south of Kenansville:

NC 903-NC 11 from the intersection of NC 50-24, southward to the intersection of SR 1003-1959.

DIVISION 3

DUPLIN COUNTY - CONTINUED

Delete the following routing of SR 1003 and add as NC 903, in and north of Magnolia:

SR 1003 from the intersection of NC 903-NC 11, southward to the intersection of US 117.
