BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

US ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 13

BUNCOMBE COUNTY

Add the following routing of US 74, in Asheville:

US 74-70 from the intersection of US 70 and US 74, northward to I-240.

Add the following routing of US 74, in Asheville:

US 74-I-240-US 70 from the intersection of I-240, westward to I-240-US 19-23 Business.

Add the following routing of US 74, in Asheville:

US 74-US 19-23 Bypass from the intersection of I-240-US 19-23 Business, westward to US 19-23.

Add the following routing of US 74, in and west of Asheville:

US 74-19-23 from the intersection of US 19-23 Business-SR 1319, westward to the Haywood County Line.

DIVISION 14

HAYWOOD COUNTY

Add the following routing of US 74, in and east of Canton:

US 74-19-23 from the Buncombe County Line, westward to the intersection of US 19E-23E and US 19W-23W.

HAYWOOD COUNTY - CONTINUED

Add the following routing of US 74W, in Canton:

US 74W-19W-23W from the intersection of US 19E-23E, westward to US 19E-23E and NC 215.

Add the following routing of US 74E, in Canton:

US 74E-19E-23E-NC 215 from the intersection of US 19W-23W and NC 215, eastward to the intersection of US 19E-23E and NC 215.

Add the following routing of US 74E, in Canton:

US 74E-19E-23E from the intersection of NC 215, eastward to US 19W-23W.

Add the following routing of US 74, in Canton:

US 74-19-23 and NC 215 from the intersection of US 19E-23E and NC 215, westward to NC 215.

Add the following routing of US 74, in and west of Canton:

US 74-19-23 from the intersection of NC 215, westward to US 19-23 Bypass.

Add the following routing of US 74, east and west of Waynesville:

US 74-US 19-23 Bypass from the intersection of US 19, westward to the Jackson County Line.

JACKSON COUNTY

Add the following routing of US 74, east and west of Sylva:

US 74-US 19-23 Bypass from the Haywood County Line, westward to the intersection of US 441-23.

JACKSON COUNTY - CONTINUED

Add the following routing of US 74, west of Sylva:

US 74-441-US 19 Bypass from the intersection of US 441-23, westward to the intersection of US 441.

Add the following routing of US 74, west of Sylva:

US 74-19 Bypass from the intersection of US 441, westward to the Swain County Line.

SWAIN COUNTY

Add the following routing of US 74, east of Bryson City:

US 74-19 Bypass from the Jackson County Line, westward to the intersection of US 19.

Add the following routing of US 74, west of Bryson City:

US 74-19 from the intersection of US 19, westward to NC 28.

Add the following routing of US 74, west of Bryson City:

US 74-19-NC 28 from the intersection of NC 28, westward to the west intersection of US 19-NC 28.

Add the following routing of US 74, west of Bryson City:

US 74-19 from the intersection of NC 28, southwestward to the Macon County Line.

Add the following routing of US 74, northwest of Franklin:

US 74-19 from the Swain County Line, southward to US 129.

Add the following routing of US 74, northwest of Franklin:

US 74-19-129 from the intersection of US 129, southward to the Cherokee County Line.

CHEROKEE COUNTY

Add the following routing of US 74, in and near Andrews:

US 74-19-129 from the Macon County Line, southwestward to US 64.

Add the following routing of US 74, in and near Murphy:

US 74-19-64-129 from the intersection of US 64, southwestward to US 19-129.

Add the following routing of US 74, south of Murphy:

US 74-64 from the intersection of US 19-129, westward to the Tennessee State Line.
