BOARD OF TRANSPORTATION
HIGHWAY TRAFFIC ORDINANCES

The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 1

PERQUIMANS COUNTY

Delete the following routing of NC 37, in Hertford:

US 17 Business-NC 37 from the southern junction with US 17 Bypass, northward to the junction of US 17 Business-NC 37 at the Winfall-Hertford corporate limits.

Add the following routing of NC 37, in Winfall:

US 17 Business from the junction of US 17 Business-NC 37 at the Winfall-Hertford corporate limits, northward to SR 1300.

Add the following routing of NC 37, in and south of Hertford and in Winfall:

US 17 Bypass from the southern junction of US 17 Bypass-US 17 Business-NC 37, northward to the northern junction of US 17 Bypass-SR 1300.

Delete the following routing of SR 1300 and add as NC 37, in Winfall:

SR 1300 from US 17 Business, eastward to US 17 Bypass.
