The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

NC ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 5

DURHAM COUNTY

Delete the following routing of SR 1003 (Guess Road) and add as NC 157, in and near Durham:

SR 1003 (Guess Road) from I-85, northward to the Orange County Line, a distance of 9.30 miles.

DIVISION 7

ORANGE COUNTY

Delete the following routing of SR 1003 (Guess Road) and add as NC 157, north of Hillsborough:

SR 1003 (Guess Road) from the Durham County Line, northward to NC 57, a distance of 4.50 miles.

US 25-70 from SR 1151-1147, northward to the northern intersection of US 25-70 (Project 8.1860105).

Add the following routing of US 25-70, at Walnut:

US 25-70 along Project 8.1860105 from US 25-70-NC 213, northward to existing US 25-70.
