The Board of Transportation has delegated to the Secretary of Transportation the authority to adopt and promulgate all rules and regulations and ordinances regulating traffic on the highways pursuant to authority of N.C.G.S. 143B-350 (f), (g) (see 19ANCAC 4A.0004).

Pursuant to that delegation, the Secretary of Transportation hereby adopts and promulgates the following ordinances based on traffic and engineering studies performed by the Traffic Engineering Branch, Department of Transportation, and in accordance with General Statute 136-30, 136-54.

US ROUTE CHANGES

DIVISION 12

IREDELL COUNTY

Delete the following routing of US64 Alternate in and west of Statesville:

US64 Alternate- US70 from the intersection of NC90 (Front Street) with Newton Drive in Statesville, westward to the Catawba County Line.

DIVISION 12

CATAWBA COUNTY

Delete the following routing of US64 Alternate, near and in Conover:

US64 Alternate - US 70 from the Iredell County Line, westward to the intersection of US321, in Conover.

Delete the following routing of US64 Alternate in and west of Conover:

US64 Alternate - US70 - US321 from the intersection of US321 in Conover, westward to the intersection of US321, in Hickory.

DIVISION 12

CATAWBA COUNTY CONTINUED

Delete the following routing of US64 Alternate in and near Hickory:

US64 Alternate - US70 from the intersection of US321 in Hickory, westward to the Burke County Line.

DIVISION 13

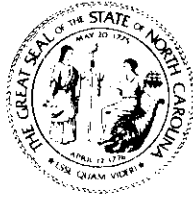
BURKE COUNTY

Delete the following routing of US64 Alternate near and in Morganton:

US64 Alternate - US70 from the Catawba County Line, westward to the east intersection of US64 Bypass - US70 Bypass.

Delete the following routing of US64 Alternate, in Morganton:

US64 Alternate - US70 Bypass from the east intersection of US64 Business - US 70 Business(Union Street), westward to the intersection of US 64 Business (Burkemont Avenue).
