General description of request (starting/ending points, etc.):

Extend NC 45 from its current southern terminus at SR 1128 (Oyster Creek Road) as follows: along the Swan Quarter-Ocracoke ferry route between SR 1128 and NC 12 on Ocracoke.

Reason/Justification for this route change:

NC 45 currently ends at SR 1128 at the entrance to the Swan Quarter Ferry terminal. Extending the route would allow NC 45 to end at another NC route and provides a "marine highway" for the Ferry Division, which is useful for expedited dredging operations in emergency situations.

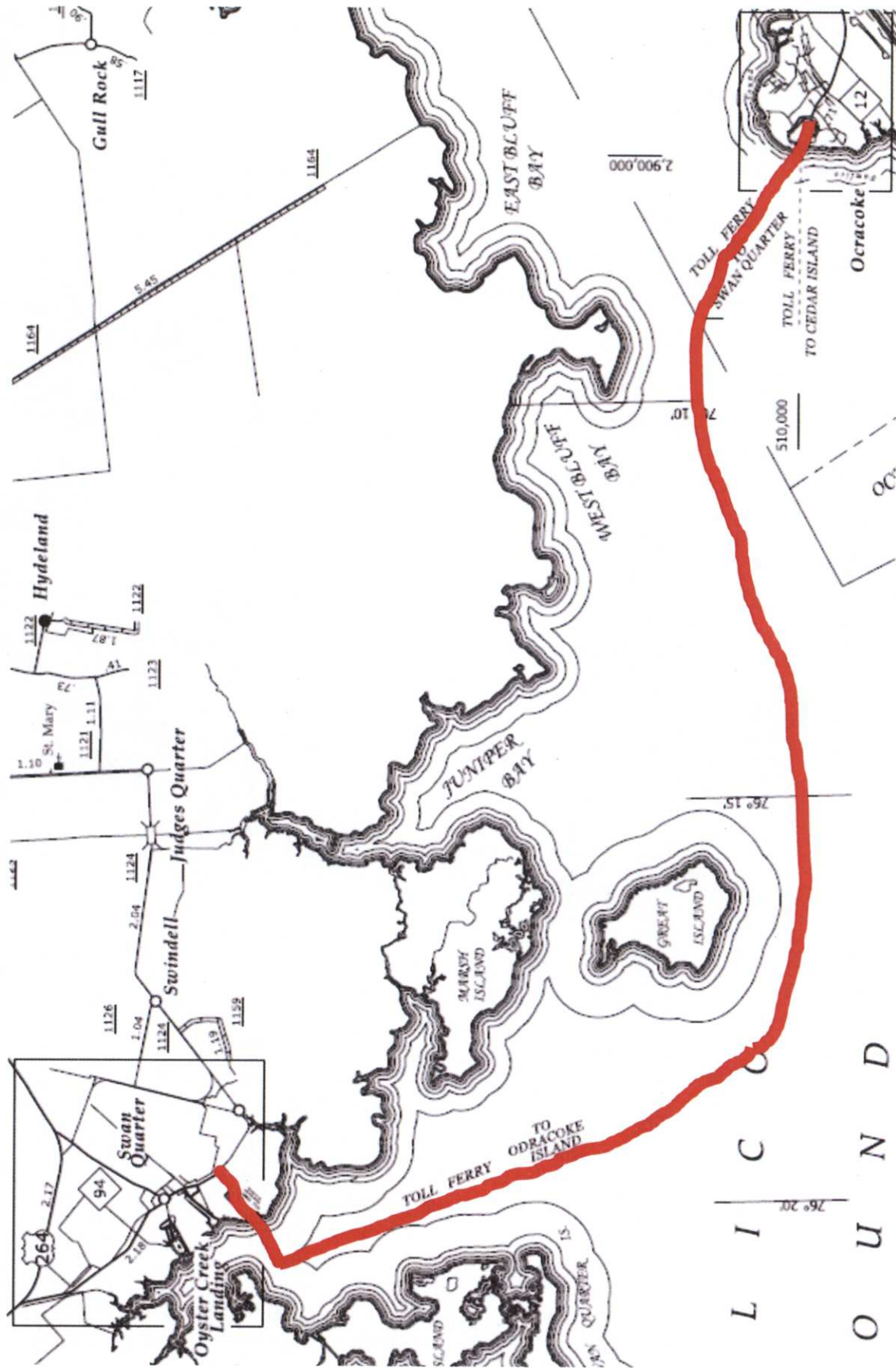

Sterling,

I spoke with Kevin Lacy about extending primary routes across the ferries as we discussed on Tuesday. He is agreeable with extending the following:

- NC 615 from Knott's Island to NC 168, Currituck County
- NC 45 from Swan Quarter to Ocracoke, Hyde County
- NC 211 from Southport to Fort Fisher, Brunswick and New Hanover Counties

I also asked him about providing routes for the emergency ferries from Stumpy Point to Rodanthe and Hatteras, but we are reluctant to add anything to the system since they are not operational except in emergencies, there is no logical route to consider for extension, and we are under a mandate to curtail our NC route mileage.

I will begin processing these requests and will advise Div. 3 of this action. PLMK of any questions or concerns.
