

RESOLUTION BY THE TOWN OF BAILEY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS CONCURRING WITH NORTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RECOMMENDATIONS TO RELOCATE NC 581 FROM SANFORD STREET BENEATH THE RAILROAD OVERPASS ONTO THE EXISTING NC 581 TRUCK ROUTE AND REDESIGNATE THE BLOCK OF SANFORD STREET BETWEEN MAIN STREET CHINGED DEANS STREET AS A STATE-MAINTAINED SECONDARY ROAD

WHEREAS, the North Carolina Department of Transportation maintains NC 581 Sanford Street between SR 1973 (Main Street) and US 264A (Deans Street); and Div. 4 - District II

WHEREAS, there is a low-clearance railroad overpass over NC 581 (Sanford Street) on this block of NC 581 (Sanford Street); and

WHEREAS, there were nine crashes reported between May 1, 2008 and April 30, 2013 where a vehicle struck the low-clearance railroad overpass; and

WHEREAS, eight of these crashes involved drivers from outside the immediate vicinity of Bailey; and

WHEREAS, the Carolina and Northwestern Railway will not allow roadway improvements beneath their railroad overpass; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Bailey desires to continue allowing vehicular traffic access beneath the railroad overpass;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Bailey Board of Commissioners concurs with the North Carolina Department of Transportation recommendations to: 1) relocate NC 581 from Sanford Street and onto the existing NC 581 Truck Route along Main Street, Benson Street, and Deans Street; and 2) redesignate the block of Sanford Street between Main Street and Deans Street as a state-maintained secondary road.
