NC-133 will exist on new location between NC-87 and NC-211 (Southport-Supply Road), and between NC 211 and NC-133 (Long Beach Road). NC-133 will traverse between NC-133 (~milepost 3.178) and NC-211 (~milepost 9.209), between NC 211 and NC-87/NC-133 (~milepost 2.390/6.039).

Reason/Justification for this route change:

R-3324 is constructing this route on new location. Upon completion it will provide a more direct route to NC-87 and NC-133 to travel to points north.

A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE REDESIGNATION OF NC 133 IN BRUNSWICK COUNTY TO THE NEW LONG BEACH RD EXTENSION (R-3324)

WHEREAS, the Cape Fear Rural Transportation Planning Organization (RPO) was established to facilitate the coordination of transportation planning efforts between the North Carolina Department of Transportation (NCDOT) and local officials in the Cape Fear RPO planning boundary; and


WHEREAS, the Rural Transportation Advisory Committee (RTAC) is the duly established transportation planning policy board for the Cape Fear RPO; and

WHEREAS, NCDOT is currently constructing the Long Beach Rd Extension project (R-3324) on new location between NC 87 (approximately 0.8 mile south of NC 133 and NC 87 intersection) and NC 211 (approximately 800 feet west of the current NC 133 (Long Beach Road) and NC 211 intersection) then between NC 211 and existing NC 133 (Long Beach Road) approximately 1550 feet southwest of NC 211; and

WHEREAS, the Cape Fear RPO RTAC believes that redesignating NC 133 to follow the Long Beach Rd Extension is appropriate and desirable.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved that the Cape Fear RPO Rural Transportation Advisory Committee hereby supports the redesignation of NC 133 in Brunswick County to follow the new Long Beach Rd Extension (R-3324).
