SURRY COUNTY

Delete the following routing of NC 89, and add as a secondary road, in Mount Airy:

NC 89 (West Pine Street) from SR 1670 (Independence Boulevard) eastward to US 52 Business (Renfro Street). (Length 0.84 mile).

Delete the following routing of SR 1670 and add as NC 89 in Mount Airy:

SR 1670 (Independence Boulevard) from NC 89 (West Pine Street) eastward to US 52 Business (Renfro Street). (Length 0.83 mile).

Add the following routing of NC 89 in Mount Airy:

US 52 Business-NC 89 (Renfro Street) from SR 1670 (Independence Boulevard) southward to NC 103 (East Pine Street). (Length 0.27 mile).

DIVISION 13

BUNCOMBE COUNTY

Delete the following routing of US 74 in and west of Asheville:

US 19-23-74 from the Haywood County Line east to I-40 at Exit 44.

Add the following routing of US 74:

Along I-40 from the Haywood County Line east of US 19-23-74Alt. at Exit 44 west of Asheville.
