

#### Dear Don:

This letter is in response to your letter of June 22<sup>nd</sup> concerning proposed changes in road signage in Dare County brought about by the new bridge construction over Croatan Sound.

At its meeting yesterday the Dare County Board of Commissioners voted unanimously to support the following:

- 1. Eliminate U.S. 264 from the intersection west of Manns Harbor that involves the road from Stumpy Point to Whalebone Junction in Nags Head.
- 2. Leaving N.C. 400 as is with no expansion to Manns Harbor as had been proposed.
- Designate the new bypass as U.S. 64 Bypass.
- 4. Designate the existing U.S. 64/264 through Manteo as U.S. 64.

I hope this letter addresses your concerns and the Dare County Board of Commissioners appreciates the opportunity to have input into this matter.
