




## GENERAL NOTES:

- 1- USE SOLID WHITE DOUBLE LANE LINES WHEN CROSSING IS PROHIBITED, USE A SINGLE SOLID WHITE LANE LINE IF CROSSING IS DISCOURAGED.
- 2- "D" = SPACING OF THE PAVEMENT MARKING TEXT "BUS" AND "ONLY". PLEASE REFER TO THE CHART ON NCDOT STD. 1205.08 FOR THE DISTANCE BETWEEN WORD SYMBOLS. HOWEVER, "D" CAN BE REDUCED TO A MINIMUM OF 10' IN URBAN AREAS, IF APPLICABLE. USE ENGINEERING JUDEGMENT TO DETERMINE REASONABLE DISTANCE BETWEEN WORD SYMBOLS.
- 3- REFER TO MUTCD TABLE 3E-1 FOR ADDITIONAL GUIDANCE FOR LANE LINE AND EDGE LINE WIDTHS FOR BUS LANES.
- 4- DUE TO THE COMPLEXIY OF URBAN STREETS, USE BEST ENGINEERING JUDGEMENT IN THE PLACEMENT OF "BUS ONLY" WORD SYMBOLS TO DENOTE THE PREFERENTIAL USE OF THE BUS LANES. SYMBOLS MAY BE PLACED VARIOUS LOCATIONS ALONG A CORRIDOR, SUCH AS:
  - A- AT THE BEGINNING OF THE BUS LANE.
  - B- IN URBAN AREAS, AT THE FAR SIDE OF ALL INTERSECTIONS AND MAJOR STREET ENTRANCES. IF THERE ARE MULTIPLE STREETS WITHIN A BLOCK, PLACE BETWEEN GROUPS OF ENTRANCÉS
  - C- IN SUBURBAN/URBAN AREAS, PLACE AT THE APPROACH AND DEPARTURE OF MAJOR INTERSECTIONS. WHERE INTERSECTIONS ARE SPACED FAR APART, PLACE IN INTERVALS NOT TO EXCEED 1000 FT.
  - D- AT THE APPROACH OF A MIXING ZONE FOR A POCKET TURN LANE, OR AT THE APPROACH OF A SHARED BUS/TURN LANE. E- AT BUS STOP LOCATIONS.

  - F- ADDITIONAL SYMBOLS MAY BE PLACED AT HEAVY TRAFFIC CONFLICT AREAS TO REMIND MOTORISTS OF THE PREFERENTIAL USE OF THE BUS LANES. EXAMPLES WOULD BE BEFORE A MERGE AREA, BEFORE A SHARED BUS/TURN LANE, OR BEFORE WHERE THERE IS A DRIVEWAY THAT RECEIVES A HEAVY VOLUME OF MOTOR VEHICLES. AVOID PLACING SYMBOLS IN AREAS WHERE MOTORISTS WOULD TRACK THROUGH THE SYMBOLS SUCH AS MERGE AREAS, DRIVEWAY ENTRANCES, OR WITHIN THE TURNING
- 5- SEE MUTCD SECTION 2G.06 FOR GUIDANCE ON TYPICAL SIGNING FOR PREFERENTIAL LANES. SUCH AS BUS LANES.







GENERAL NOTES:

- 1- RED COLORED PAVEMENT APPLICATION IS AN OPTIONAL TREATMENT THAT CAN BE PLACED AT STRATEGIC LOCATIONS USING ENGINEERING JUDGEMENT. WHEN INSTALLED, RED COLORED PAVEMENT SHALL BE INSTALLED FOR THE ENTIRE WIDTH OF THE BUS LANE.
- 2- REFER TO NCDOT STD. 1205.09 FOR GUIDANCE ON APPLICATION OF PAVEMENT MARKINGS FOR CHANNELIZING ISLAND SEPARATING TRAFFIC IN THE SAME DIRECTION.
- 3- "BUSES ONLY" (R3-11B) SIGNS MAY BE PLACED OVERHEAD FOR THE BUS LANE.
- 4- "DO NOT ENTER" (R5-1) SIGNS MAY BE PLACED TO DETER WRONG WAY MOVEMENTS. REFER TO MUTCD 2B.46 FOR GUIDANCE ON PLACEMENT.
- 5- REFER TO MUTCD PART 4 FOR GUIDANCE ON SIGNALIZATION FOR INTERSECTIONS WITH BUS ONLY LANES.
