SIGN CLEANING:

(9-15-26)

Description

Clean existing Department-maintained sign faces of dirt, debris, and vandalism at locations shown in the plans, listed in the contract or as directed by the Engineer.

Materials

Use a liquid, non-abrasive cleaner free of damaging solvents recommended for use by the sign sheeting manufacturer. Use clean potable water for rinsing the sign face.

Construction Methods

Clean sign face using materials and equipment that are not detrimental to the sign sheeting, overlay, hardware, or supports. The process and materials used shall not reduce or compromise the visibility or retroreflectivity of the sign. Do not use high pressure sprayers, harsh solvents and chemicals, and any abrasive cleaners, brushes, cloths, or scouring pads.

Clean signs using material, equipment, and process meeting the requirements of this provision.

Prior to beginning work, submit the cleaning material, equipment, and process used for sign cleaning to the Engineer for review and approval.

Traffic control and mobilization shall be incidental to sign cleaning and in accordance with the *Standard Specifications, Roadway Standard Drawings*, and the contract unless otherwise specified in the contract. Protect adjacent traffic, pedestrians, property, and drainage features from cleaning operations.

Before cleaning, document and provide to the Engineer existing damage, deterioration, delamination, missing sheeting, cracked overlays, or other conditions that may affect cleaning or acceptance. Notify the Engineer of signs that appear unsuitable for cleaning before cleaning those signs. The Engineer may physically inspect the sign for damage prior to acceptance. Any signs sheeting, overlay, hardware, or supports damaged by the cleaning process will be repaired or replaced by the Contractor at no cost to the Department.

Measurement and Payment

Sign Cleaning will be measured and paid in square feet of sign face satisfactorily cleaned and accepted. Such price and payment shall be full compensation for all labor, equipment and materials required to satisfactorily clean the signs, all traffic control, mobilization and other incidentals necessary to complete the work.

Sign cleaning will be measured and paid as *Sign Cleaning (Overhead)* when the sign is located over a travel lane otherwise the sign cleaned will be measured and paid as *Sign Cleaning*.
