WAZE	<p>Confirm issue on <a href="https://waze.com/livemap">Waze.com/livemap</a>                      If map is wrong, then follow steps below:</p> <p><b>App</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Tap the orange triangular (!) icon at the bottom right corner.</li> <li>2. Select “Map issue”</li> <li>3. Provide a detailed description of the discrepancy.</li> </ol> <p><b>Web Browser</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Go to Waze Map Editor (can be found using Google search)</li> <li>2. Log in using your Waze account. You can log in quickly by scanning the QR code.</li> <li>3. Edit the map and submit changes for review. Follow the provided instructions.</li> </ol>
Google Maps	<p>Confirm issue on <a href="https://google.com/maps">Google.com/maps</a>                      If map is wrong, follow instructions here:</p> <p><b>Web Browser</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. In Google Maps, navigate to the problem location.</li> <li>2. Right-click on the road or point-of-interest (POI)</li> <li>3. Report a data problem. Follow the instructions. <a href="#">FAQ</a>.</li> </ol> <p><b>App</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Long-press a location</li> <li>2. Suggest an edit</li> </ol>
Apple Maps	<p>Confirm issue is wrong on the native map on an Apple Device. You can only edit POIs in the app. To suggest map edits, you must use macOS.</p> <p><b>iPhone App</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Long-press a location</li> <li>2. To add a new POI: Report something missing</li> <li>3. To edit an existing POI: select the POI to open the Place Card &gt; report an issue</li> </ol> <p><b>Apple Maps on macOS</b></p>

	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Open Apple Maps: Launch the app on your Mac.</li> <li>2. Find the Location: Navigate to the area with the issue.</li> <li>3. Report an Issue: Click on "Maps" in the menu bar and select "Report an Issue".</li> <li>4. Choose Issue Type: Select from options like "Add to Maps," "Report a Problem," or "Suggest a Change".</li> <li>5. Provide Details: Fill out the form with accurate information about the discrepancy.</li> <li>6. Submit: Click "Send" to submit your report.</li> </ol> <p><b>Business on Apple Maps</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. To claim or create a business on Apple Maps go to <a href="https://www.apple.com/business/connect/">https://www.apple.com/business/connect/</a></li> <li>2. Sign Up (you will need an apple ID)</li> <li>3. Validate you own the business</li> <li>4. Update business within your apple map business account.</li> </ol>
Bing Maps (This is the base map used in DriveNC.gov and TIMS)	<p>Confirm issue here: <a href="https://www.bing.com/maps">https://www.bing.com/maps</a></p> <p><b>Web Browser</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Visit Bing Maps: Go to Bing Maps.</li> <li>2. Locate the Area: Navigate to the map area with the issue.</li> <li>3. Access Feedback: Click on "Feedback" at the bottom right corner.</li> <li>4. Report a Problem: Select "Report a map problem" from the options.</li> <li>5. Provide Details: Fill out the form with accurate information about the discrepancy.</li> <li>6. Submit: Click "Submit" to send your report.</li> </ol>

Garmin Device and HERE Maps	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Confirm issue here: <a href="https://wego.here.com">https://wego.here.com</a></li> </ol> <p><b>Web Browser</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Visit HERE Maps: Go to <a href="https://wego.here.com/">https://wego.here.com/</a>.</li> <li>2. Create an Account: Sign up or log in if you already have an account.</li> <li>3. Navigate to the Location: Use the map to navigate to the area with the issue.</li> <li>4. Access Feedback: "Gear" menu in upper right near your account initials. Click on "Give Feedback" option</li> <li>5. Report the Problem: Send an email to the address shown: <a href="mailto:appsupport@here.com">appsupport@here.com</a>. Describe the relevant information about the discrepancy or map error, provide coordinates and screenshots as needed.</li> <li>6. Submit: Click "Submit" to send your report.</li> </ol>
Open Street Maps	<p>Confirm issue on <a href="https://openstreetmap.org">openstreetmap.org</a></p>

**Web Browser**

1. Visit OpenStreetMap: Go to [OpenStreetMap](#).
2. Create an Account: Sign up or log in if you already have an account.
3. Navigate to the Location: Use the map to find the area with the issue.
4. Enter Edit Mode: Click on "Edit" at the top of the page (choose "Edit with iD (in-browser editor)" for ease).
5. Make Changes: Use the editing tools to correct or update the map data.
6. Add a Change Comment: Provide a brief summary of your edits.
7. Save Your Work: Click "Save" to submit your changes.
