TE-PS-10 FIRE STATION WARNING SIGN

- a. State Rural System: FIRE STATION warning signs will be erected by the NCDOT upon request but only at locations that meet all of the following warrants:
 - 1. Traffic volumes on the road in front of the fire station must average at least 1000 vehicles per day.
 - 2. A substantial amount of the traffic must be foreign in nature, i.e., out-of-state or non-local (non-repeat). Foreign or non-local traffic is that which does not use the route daily or several times weekly.
 - 3. The signs will be erected only on roads meeting warrants (1) and (2) of this subparagraph and then only for fire stations where the stopping sight distance is less than six hundred feet along one or both approaches to the driveway(s).
 - a. FIRE STATION warning signs will not be erected at locations where the speed limit is 35 mph or less.
