SUBJECT: *Transmittal of Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) Factsheet*

We are enclosing copies of the recently printed diverging diamond interchange factsheets for you and your staff's use at public meetings. This information was put together to help provide a consistent message from all 14 Divisions and other Departments in the DOT. The first DDI was opened to traffic in 2009 in Springfield, Mo. DDIs are currently being considered or constructed in 13 other states including North Carolina. As part of the interstate construction projects in Concord, a DDI is being constructed at the intersection of I-485 and Mallard Creek Road, as well as on I-85 at both Poplar Tent Road and NC 73.
