Subject: Alternate Sign for Urban Bicycle Routes SIGNS

The subject sign was approved by your office on October 31, 1989 as an alternate to the D11-1 sign in the MUTCD and is for use in municipalities only. The alternate sign consists of a bicycle symbol at the top with a bicycle route schematic directly underneath. To date, we have not been requested to approve this sign for use on Federal-aid projects.

Recently, we received an authorization package for a bicycle route signing project in Winston-Salem; BW-F-37-1(43), ID No. M-173. This project creates 14 bicycle routes within the city and proposes to install 147 of the subject signs as part of this project. This letter is to advise you we consider this sign acceptable for use on Federal-aid projects in accordance with the criteria attached to Mr. Crowe's October 31, 1989 letter. We recommend the sign and usage criteria be included in the next update of North Carolina's supplement to the MUTCD.
