

2C-30 Delineators (W23-10, W23-12)

At bridges with restricted width, i.e., where the full lane or shoulder width is not carried across the bridge, W23-10 delineators shall be posted on both sides of the approach ends. The W23-10 delineator shall be posted at all bridges with wheel guards. Where the full roadway and shoulder width are carried across the structure, and no wheel guards are present, three amber delineators may be used in lieu of the W23-10. See Figure 2-19.

The traffic edge of the delineator shall be in line with the part of the structure nearest the traveled way. The bottom edge of the delineator is usually placed 2' above the roadway. However, the bottom edge may be placed as high as 4' above the roadway to prevent damage and dirt accumulation. The delineator stripes shall slope upward and outward from traffic.
