

POLICY FOR THE ERECTION OF DIRECTIONAL SIGNS FOR
SPECIFIC SECTIONS OR AREAS OF INCORPORATED CITIES AND TOWNS

This policy applies to Interstate highways and other fully controlled access highways.

1. The specific section or area of a city or town shall be of regional interest.
2. The name of the specific section or area of a city or town and the location of signs must be approved by the Traffic Engineering Branch.
3. Shopping centers or other commercial establishments shall not qualify for directional signs under this policy.
4. Local subdivisions would not qualify for this type of directional sign unless the subdivision area contained a major shopping facility or some other feature that would be considered a major traffic generator.
5. The signs shall have a green background with white letters and border.
