[TE-PS-36] OUTDOOR DRAMA SIGNS

The policy for the erection of directional signs for outdoor dramas is as follows:

- 1. Outdoor drama must be State supported.
- 2. Signs may be erected a maximum distance of three miles from the location.
- 3. No signs for outdoor dramas will be erected on interstate or controlled access highways. Signs may be erected at ramp terminals from these highways if these ramp terminals are within the distance limitation.
- 4. Signs shall have a white message and border on a brown background. They shall be reflectorized.
- 5. The first line of the sign message shall read "Outdoor Drama". The second line of the sign message shall be the name of the outdoor drama, and the third line of the sign message shall be the directional arrow, either right or left. The message size shall be 6" series C letters.
- 6. Cost of the fabricating, erecting, and maintaining the signs shall be paid for by the Division of Highways.
- 7. Requests for signs for outdoor dramas shall be reviewed by the North Carolina Department of Cultural Resources and referred to the Division of Highways with their comments. The Traffic Engineering and Safety Systems Branch shall determine the location of the needed signs.
