

Policy Statement for Placement of Signs on Overheads

Placement Locations:

1. Stand alone warning and regulatory signs should be centered over the lanes they apply to.
2. Exit direction signs should be centered over the lanes to which they apply.
3. Advance guide signs should be centered over lane or lanes which the exit will form off of or become.
4. Signs with down arrows, such as an exit only, the arrows should be centered over the lanes to which they apply. If necessary the down arrows can be placed in the middle third of the lane.
5. All remaining overhead signs, in general, center over the lane to which they apply.

Priority Placements:

When you have multiple signs on a signal overhead, the location of the signs should be placed in priority order as follows:

1. Stand alone warning and regulatory signs.
2. Exit direction signs.
3. Advance guide signs.
4. All remaining overhead signs.
