## POLICY ON SIGNS FOR REGIONAL CENTERS

- 1. The Regional entity must be one that has been established by the General Statutes and approved by each county located within the regional boundaries.
- 2. The Regional entity must have a permanent office and full time staff dedicated solely for the purpose of conducting business for the regional authority.
- 3. The Regional entity must have a governing structure and taxing authority established by General Statutes to conduct business for the region.
- 4. The Regional entity shall have an adopted Master Plan with identified goals.
- 5. The Regional entity must agree to reimburse the Department of Transportation for the design, fabrication, and installation of any signs the department determines to meet the requirements of this policy.
- 6. The Regional entity shall be responsible to reimburse the Department of Transportation for all costs associated with the maintenance of any signs installed in accordance with this policy.
- 7. The Regional entity must consist of a minimum of two (2) counties to qualify under this policy for signing.
- 8. Signing for any Regional entity will be allowed on Interstate, US, and NC routes only.
- 9. The final design, field installation locations and total number of signs allowed for any Regional entity shall be the responsibility of the North Carolina Department of Transportation.
