

Addendum to T-13 and T-14:

Supplemental Signs for Traffic Generators - Specific Names of Facilities on Signs

The Department of Transportation will allow specific names of facilities on signs provided the facility fully meets all requirements included in the Department's Standard Signing Practice, with the following conditions:

The Facility must enter into a reimbursable Agreement with the Department specifying the facility pays complete costs of signs, supports, installation, all subsequent maintenance, and pays the costs upfront to revise the sign back to the generic message. It may be necessary to abbreviate or shorten the facility name for highway signing purposes. Final determination of sign message is made by the Department of Transportation. Standard supplemental guide sign letter size shall not be increased. No logos, emblems, or symbols will be permitted on signs. All other portions of the Department's Standard Signing Practice apply. The Department reserves the right to revise the message at a later date to include additional facilities or locations, to later abbreviate message, or to later remove the signs if necessary. Example situations that may require removal are roadway design changes or new installation of program signs allowing more qualifying facilities to be signed at that location.
