

## 2D-51 Municipal Zoning and Planning Limit Signs (I2-11, I2-12, I2-13, I2-14)

The (STATESVILLE) ZONING LIMIT (I2-11), the (RALEIGH) PLANNING LIMIT (I2-12) and (RALEIGH) PLANNING AND ZONING LIMIT (I2-13) signs are the Division of Highways' approved designs for signs that municipalities may wish to erect. A horizontal version of each sign is available also. The municipality may not erect these signs without the approval of the Traffic Engineering Branch.

These signs are normally erected at the right-of-way line or 30' from the edge of pavement, whichever is closer. Where this is not practical, other locations may be approved by the Traffic Engineering Branch. They shall be located as to be no hazard to motorists and so as to give minimum interference to normal highway maintenance operations. Where they cannot be erected at the limit, the I2-14 sign may be mounted beneath the limit sign, showing the distance to the limit.

Requests for the erection of zoning and planning limit signs should be sent to the Traffic Engineering Branch of the Division of Highways.

All costs involved, such as materials, installation and maintenance shall be paid by the municipality. The Division of Highways reserves the right to remove any signs that are not properly installed or maintained.

Reflectorization is not required.
