





5311 CARES Act Applications


- All 78 applications submitted in EBS
- 70 agreements in place

5307 CARES Act Applications

- 17 applications submitted
 - 14 L2 Approved
 - 1 L1 Approved
 - 2 in process by Subrecipient







Impacts of CARES Act Draw Down Speed

- New data from the federal government shows that not all airports and transit agencies needed the federal coronavirus aid provided by the CARES Act in March 2020 as urgently as others.
- As of end of June, 78% of funds to USDOT has been legally obligated, but only 21% has actually been spent.
- Slow draw down may make it more difficult for transit to justify need for additional funding in pending HEROES Act.



New Virtual Training Series Starts Sept. 22


- Eight sessions, each one to two hours long
