BRIDGE COATING INSPECTION, LEVEL I COURSE DESCRIPTION

The purpose of this class is to prepare Project Engineers and Inspectors for field coatings inspection projects on North Carolina Bridges. This course is designed to highlight and emphasize the requirements of the NCDOT *Standards Specifications* and or Project Special Provisions.

This class will provide students with a basic understanding of the corrosion process on bridge structures, illustrate the differences between the Contractor's Quality Control and the Department's Quality Assurance inspection and then students will be presented with a top down overview of the project sequence to include the pre-construction meeting. Students then will be introduced to project specific topics that include: hazardous coating removal, safety, surface preparation, coating application and combination of instruction with the hands training on equipment they will use and or witness the Contractor use during a field painting project.

Each student will receive a manual with the power point presentations and all inclusive reference manual that includes the

Project Special Provisions, NCDOT Standard Specifications, ASTM test methods and standard coating industry specifications.
